All teachers will provide students with high quality instruction using consistent district approved curriculum	Strong	Our teachers have participated in professional development sessions during the 2021/2022 school year on the implementation of enVisions and Reach for Reading to support instruction in Reading and Math.	During the 2022/2023 school year, teachers will have opportunities to participate in professional development trainings on the use of Amplify Science as well as Kagan structures to support stronger engagement opportunities for students during classroom instruction. In addition, teachers will also participate in professional development on coding strategies. All of the provided professional development opportunities on these district and schoolwide curriculum programs and expectations will help our students demonstrate overall academic growth in the core subject areas.	We need funds to send more teachers to the Kagan workshops offered in February to support strong engagement. We were able to use the funds provided in our Strategic Budget for this to send 7 teachers to this workshop. We also used funds in our Strategic Budget to bring Kagan trainers to our school during the spring full day professional development day. We could send additional teachers to the February workshop if we had an increased budget amount in our strategic budget.

We revised this third goal based on our observations on the need for more social emotional supports for our students.</p> <p>Our goal this year is to provide students with opportunities to improve their social emotional health through the use of both our school and district based supports for promoting MTSS. We currently use the program of Random Acts of Kindness and Kelso's choices to support positive behavior and conflict resolution. We also use the Panorama Survey and Hazel Health as resources to benefit students who are experiencing difficulty in school. We have organized a Behavior Intervention Team, or BIT, that meets weekly to develop individual behavior supports to assist our most struggling students in school.</p>	<p>Our next step to support this goal is to implement and monitor the implementation of teaching Kelso's Choices, Random Acts of Kindness to students in the classroom. We will also move forward with providing opportunities for students to participate in both the Panorama Survey and Hazel Health counseling sessions.</p>	<p>We need a monitoring system to evaluate the effectiveness the goal with students.</p>
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
